If a shy cat is in an individual home, he/she receives more attention as well as the love and guidance necessary to build confidence.

Smokey (pictured) is one of many GRI's fosters. He is a beautiful, grey, long hair domestic cat that becomes quickly overwhelmed when there is a lot of commotion. Smokey could benefit from a single home foster situation, without other cats or small children, to help prepare him for adoption, said Bedford.
