GRI was established in March 2020 with a mission to "Eliminate the suffering of homeless cats in the Northern Neck of Virginia."

"We never expected to reach 1,000 in only our 28th month of operation," said Bedford.

The number of homeless, unwanted cats and kittens in the Northern Neck is overwhelming for all rescues and residents. GRI continues to ask all residents to spay/neuter their pets and report homeless cats to one of the area's animal rescue organizations or county animal shelters.

The process of rescuing, fostering and preparing a cat for adoption is costly.
